- October 2005: Meet with Don Cox for clarification on approval process.
- November 2005: Meet with Dean Mayhew for direction on the type of program to implement.
- December 7, 2005: General meeting of all parties interested to discuss the program
- January 20, 2006: Subcommittee meeting on computational science program. (Jens Gregor, Chuck Collins, Christian Cardall, Robert Hinde, Cynthia Peterson, Jack Dongarra, and Peiling Wang)
- February 1, 2006: Subcommittee meeting on computational science program (Jens Gregor, Chuck Collins, Christian Cardall, Robert Hinde, Cynthia Peterson, Jack Dongarra, and Peiling Wang)
- February 3, 2006: General meeting of all parties interested to discuss the program.
- February 2006: Feedback from many interested parties integrated into catalog description.
- March 15, 2006: Dean Mayhew reviews material for the catalog.
